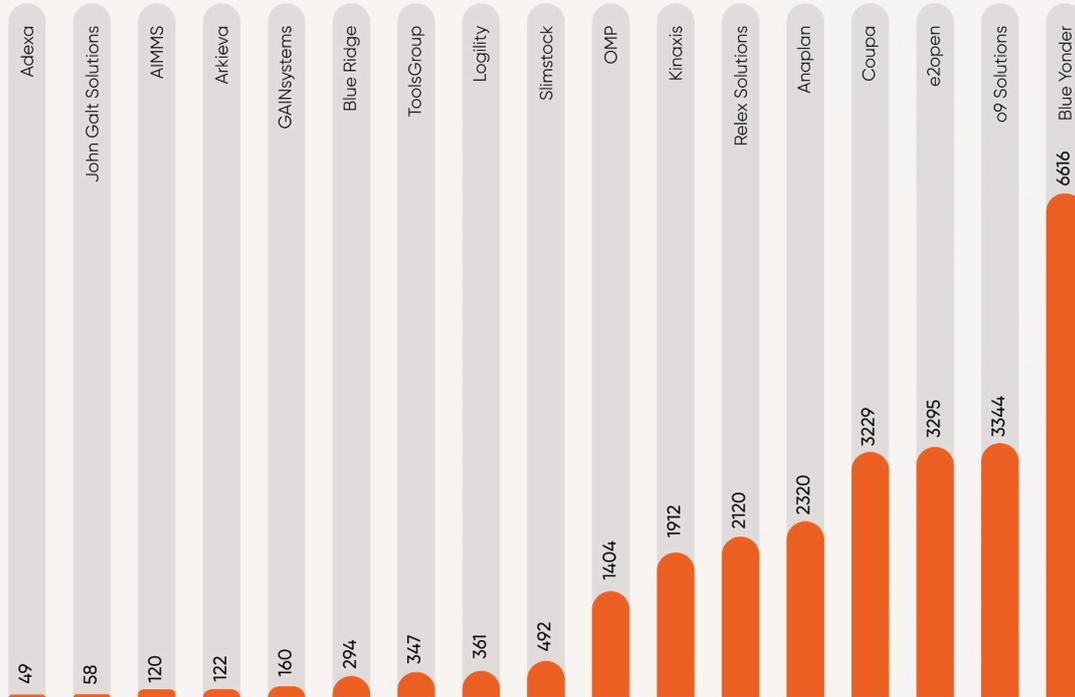

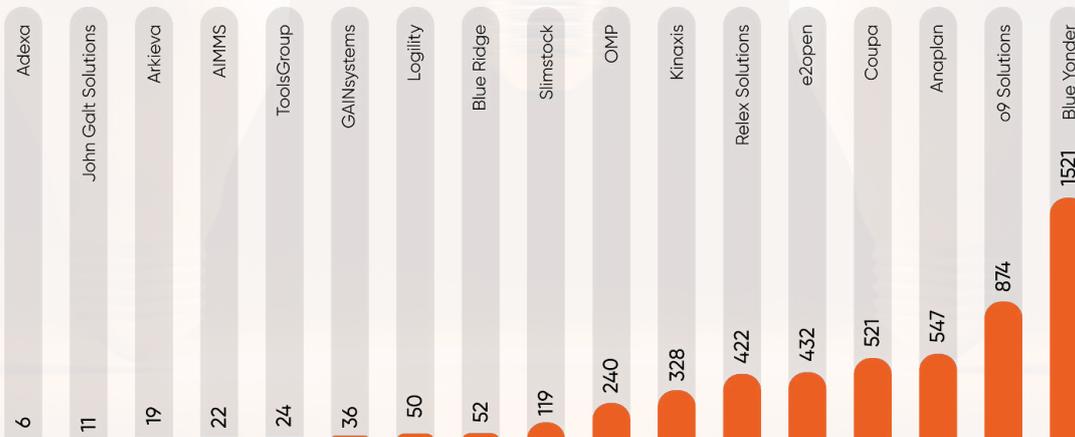
## Employee Count and New Hire Activity

Blue Yonder is clearly the market leader in the supply chain planning space with an employee count of 6,616 in October 2024. o9 Solutions and e2open follow, with counts of 3,344 and 3,295 respectively.

Blue Yonder also tops the list with 1,521 new hires, apparently doubling its number of new hires from last year suggesting an aggressive expansion strategy. o9 Solutions follows with 674 new hires, also reflecting a positive growth outlook while E2Open and Kinaxis hired far lesser employees in comparison to last year.

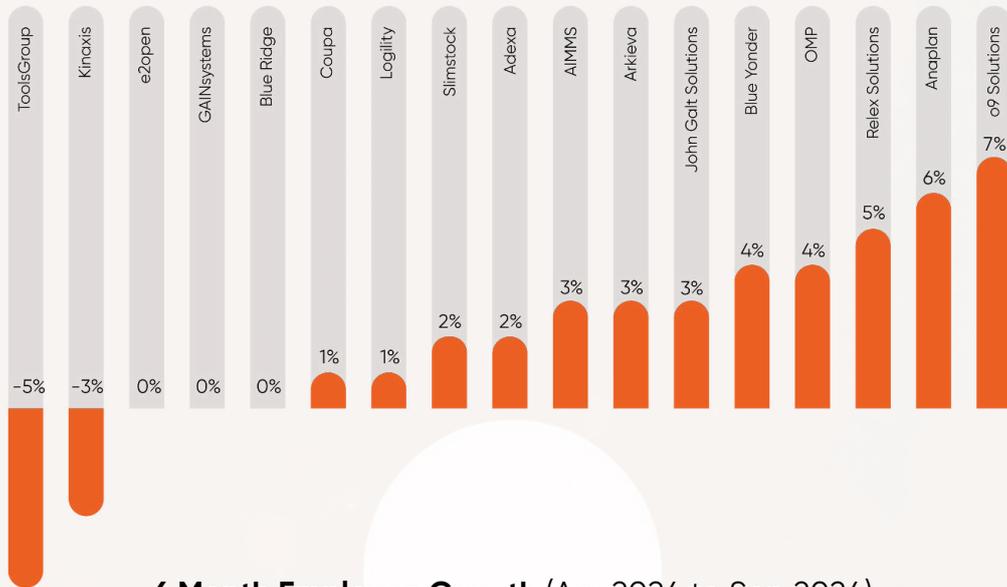


**New Hires Count** (Oct 2023 to Sep 2024)

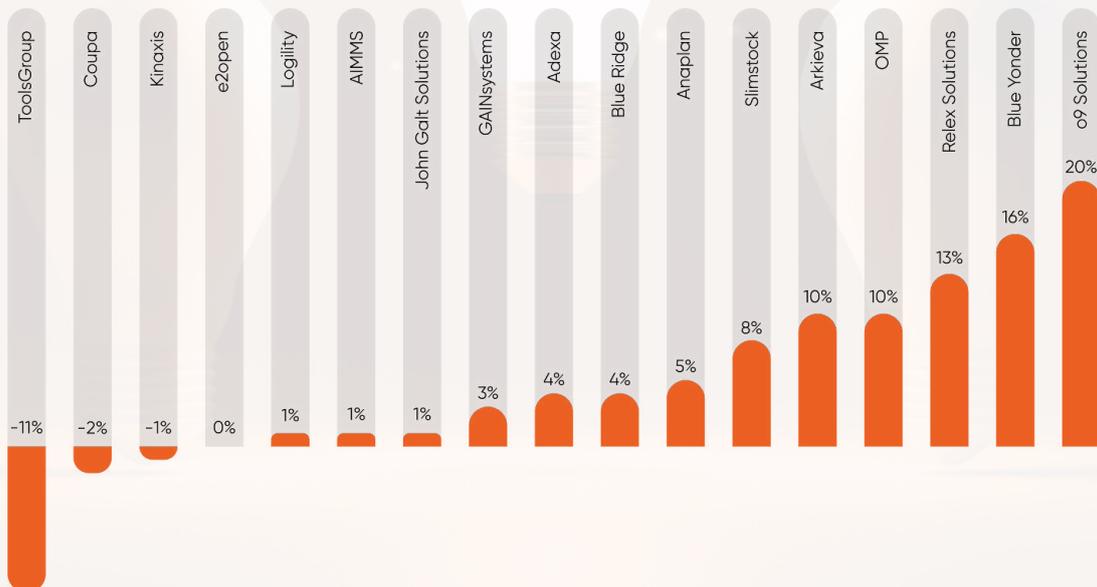
## 6 Months and 1 Year Employee Growth

There has been a notable rise in employee growth within Supply Chain Planning ISVs compared to the previous year. Although growth rates vary among different firms, companies such as Blue Yonder and o9 Solutions demonstrate robust long-term growth, even amid recent slowdowns.

On the other hand, ToolsGroup is experiencing a challenging scenario, indicating a need for strategic changes to enhance their workforce situation. This varied performance underscores the necessity of effective retention and recruitment strategies to sustain a competitive edge in the market.



6 Month Employee Growth (Apr 2024 to Sep 2024)

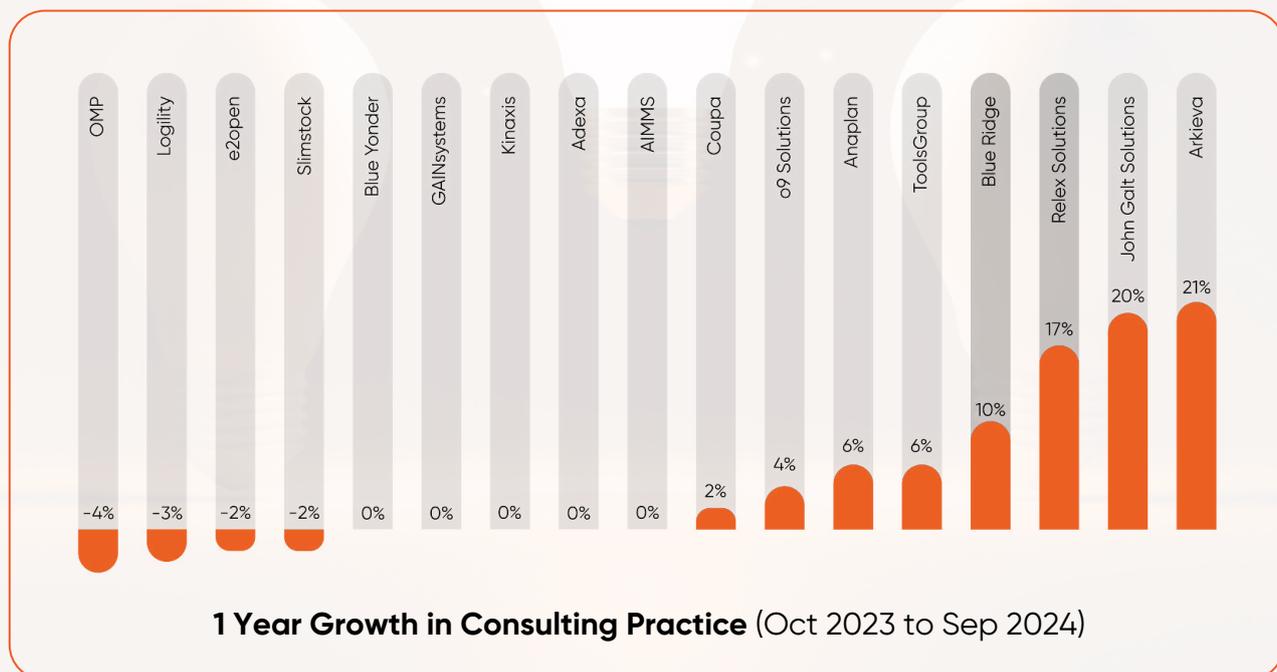


1 Year Employee Growth (Oct 2023 to Sep 2024)

The data highlights a divide between companies experiencing strong growth and those facing challenges. Firms like o9 Solutions and OMP have excelled in workforce expansion over the last two years, while GAINsystems and Coupa are unable to maintain a positive trajectory.

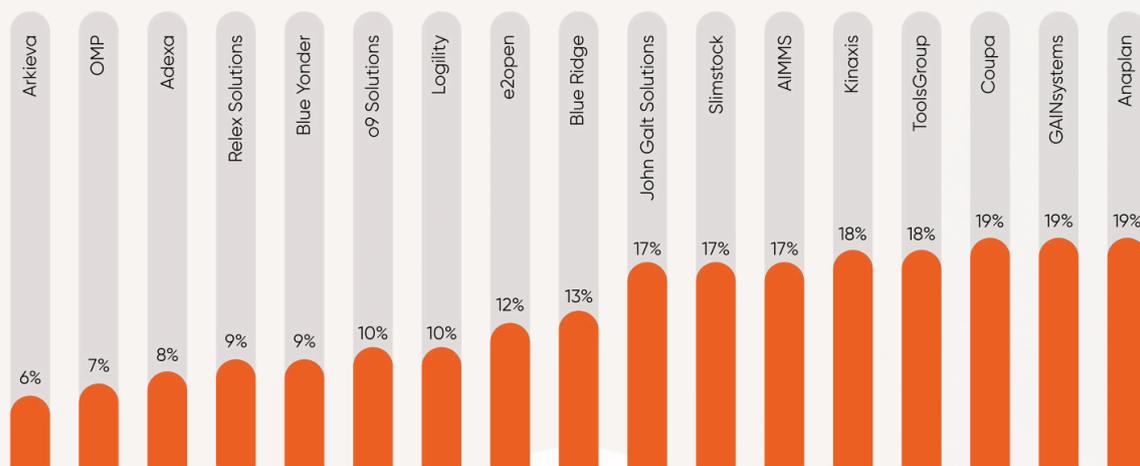
Additionally, Relex Solutions, Arkieva and John Galt are leading the growth in consulting services which could serve as a strategic advantage amidst fluctuating employee growth rates.



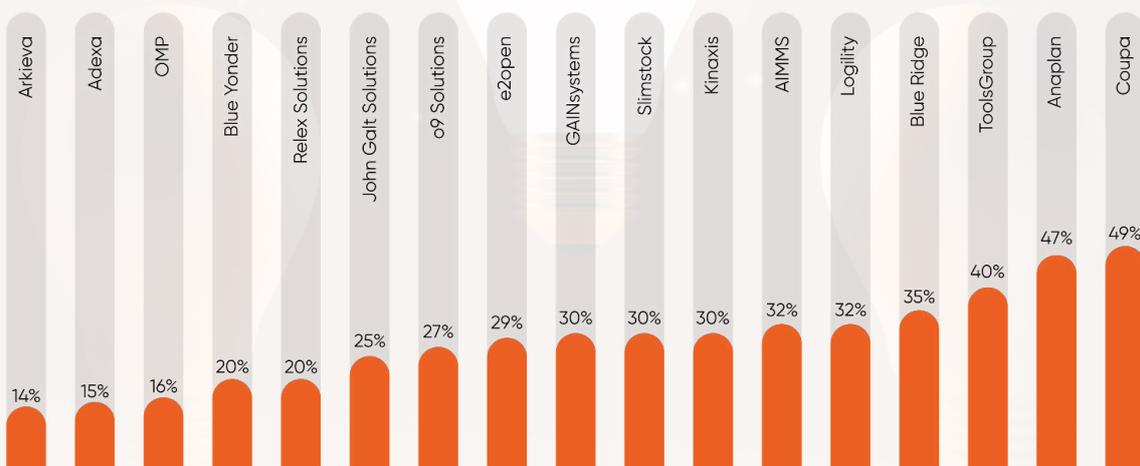
## Employee Attrition Over 1 Year and 2 Year Period

Anaplan, Coupa, and ToolsGroup are experiencing significantly elevated turnover rates, highlighting a critical necessity for these companies to reassess their recruitment and retention approaches. In contrast, Blue Yonder and o9 have reported a decrease in attrition compared to the previous year.

On the other hand, organizations with reduced turnover, like Adexa and Relex Solutions, demonstrate more positive workforce dynamics, which is consistent with their strong employee ratings in the industry.



**1 Year Employee Attrition Rate (Oct 2023 to Sep 2024)**

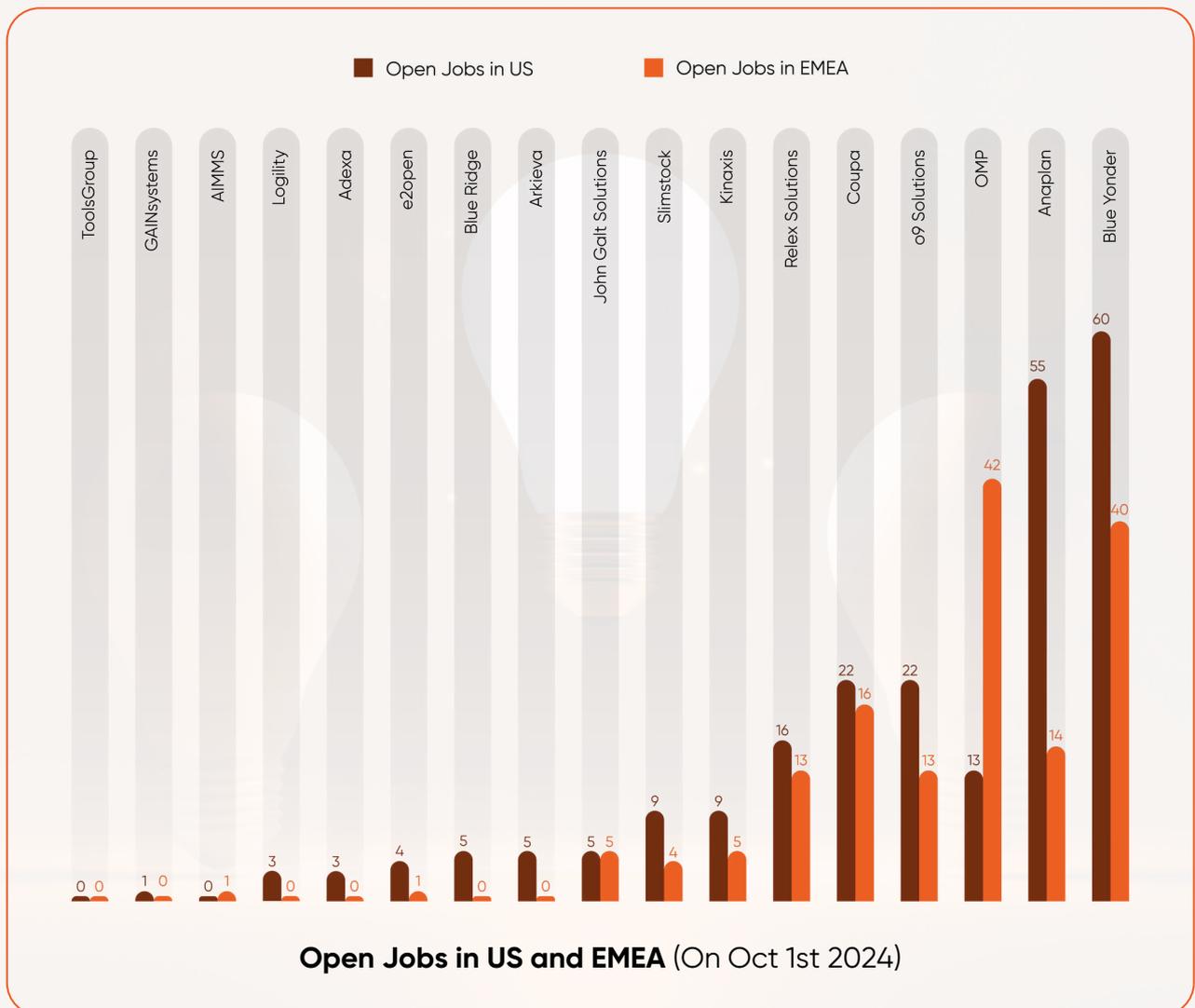


**2 Year Employee Attrition Rate (Oct 2022 to Sep 2024)**

## Number of Open Job Positions in US and EMEA

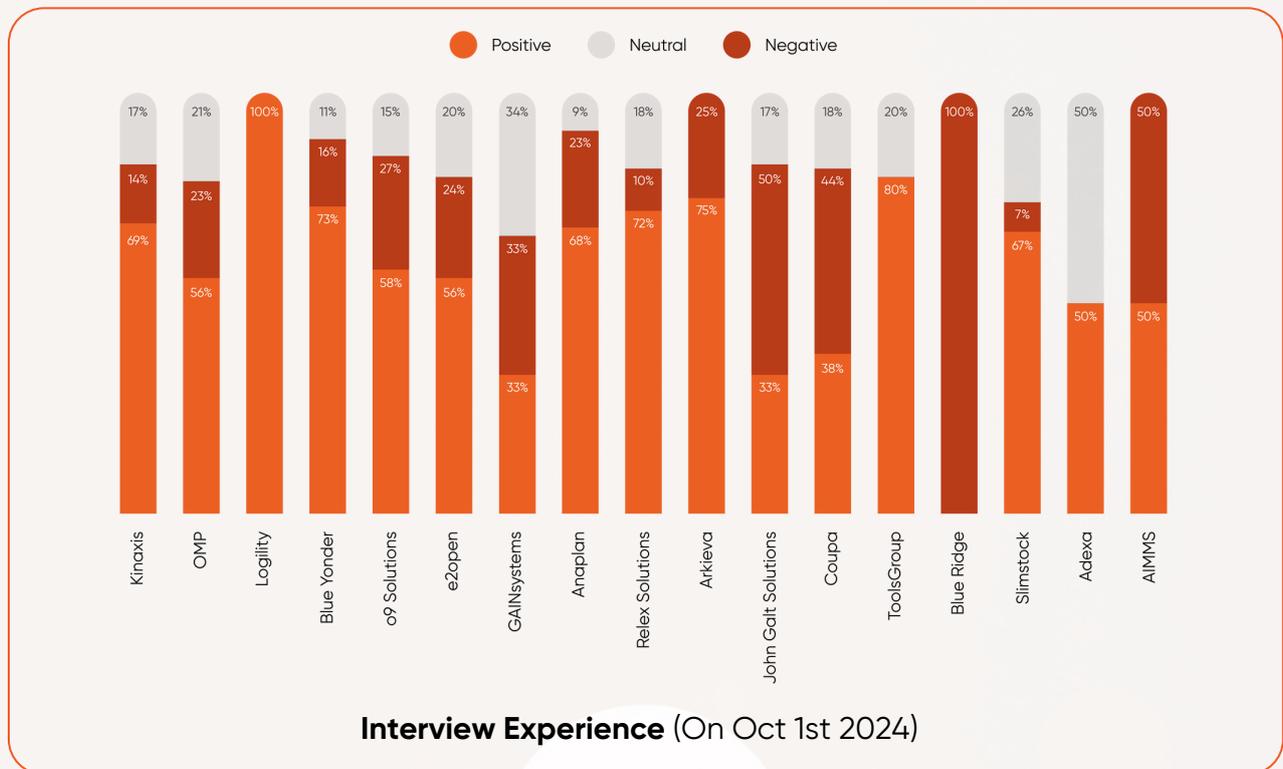
The number of job vacancies can greatly influence a company's growth and its ability to respond to market trends. In 2024, the total count of open positions has risen by nearly 35% compared to the previous year. Blue Yonder's substantial number of job openings reflects a proactive strategy to expand operations, cater to customer demands and retain its leadership position in the market. Similarly, Anaplan and OMP's high rate of available positions indicates a strong growth potential, even when factoring in their turnover rates.

Moreover, the emphasis on recruitment in the EMEA region, as demonstrated by OMP and Anaplan, points to deliberate efforts to enhance their global market footprint, which can boost revenue and provide a competitive edge. In contrast, companies with stagnant hiring trends or fewer job openings may struggle to meet demand and foster innovation and become unable to quickly adapt to market changes or seize new opportunities. In summary, a strong hiring strategy is essential for ongoing growth, improving organizational capabilities, and maintaining competitiveness in a fast-evolving business landscape.

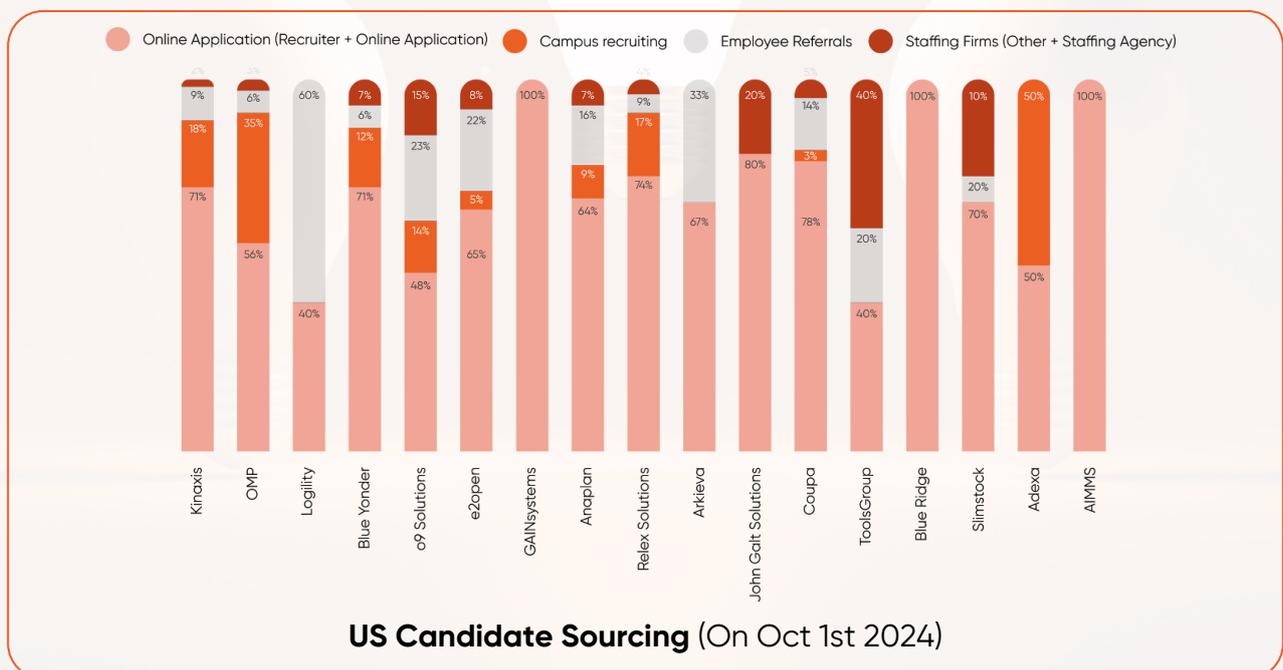


## Candidate Experience Rating & Source of Acquisition (US)

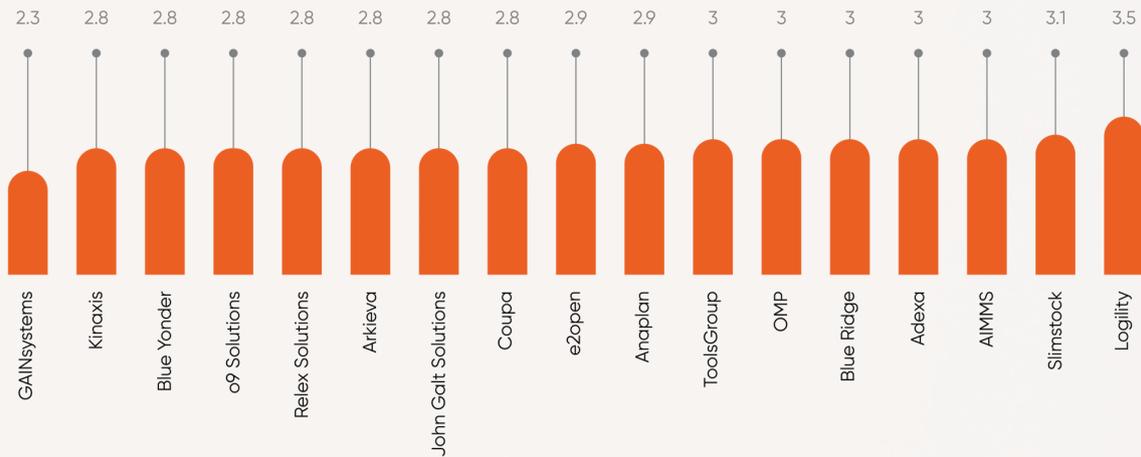


Kinaxis, GAINsystems, and Coupa rely heavily on active job seekers (those who apply online) and face significant employee turnover. In contrast, Logility and Arkieva appear to successfully utilize employee referrals in their recruitment processes, resulting in lower rates of employee attrition.



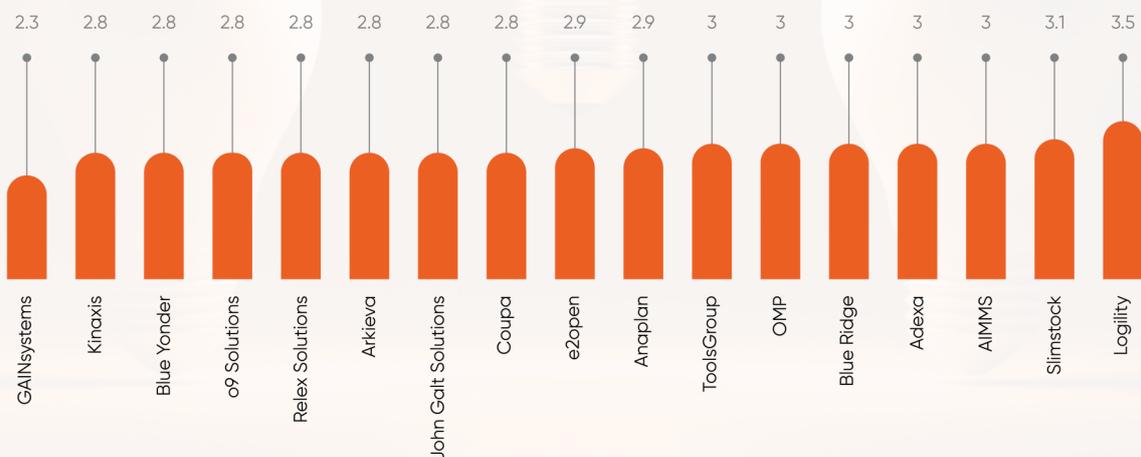
## Company Ratings - Employee & Interview Difficulty

The ratings are varied and reflect how employees view their companies. Anaplan, AIMMS, and Relex Solutions achieved the top score of 4.6. Such ratings imply a favorable workplace atmosphere and high levels of employee satisfaction, which can greatly improve these companies' appeal as employers. High ratings typically signify a robust company culture, effective management, and strong employee involvement, making these organizations more attractive to high-caliber talent.



**Employee Rating** (On Oct 1st 2024)

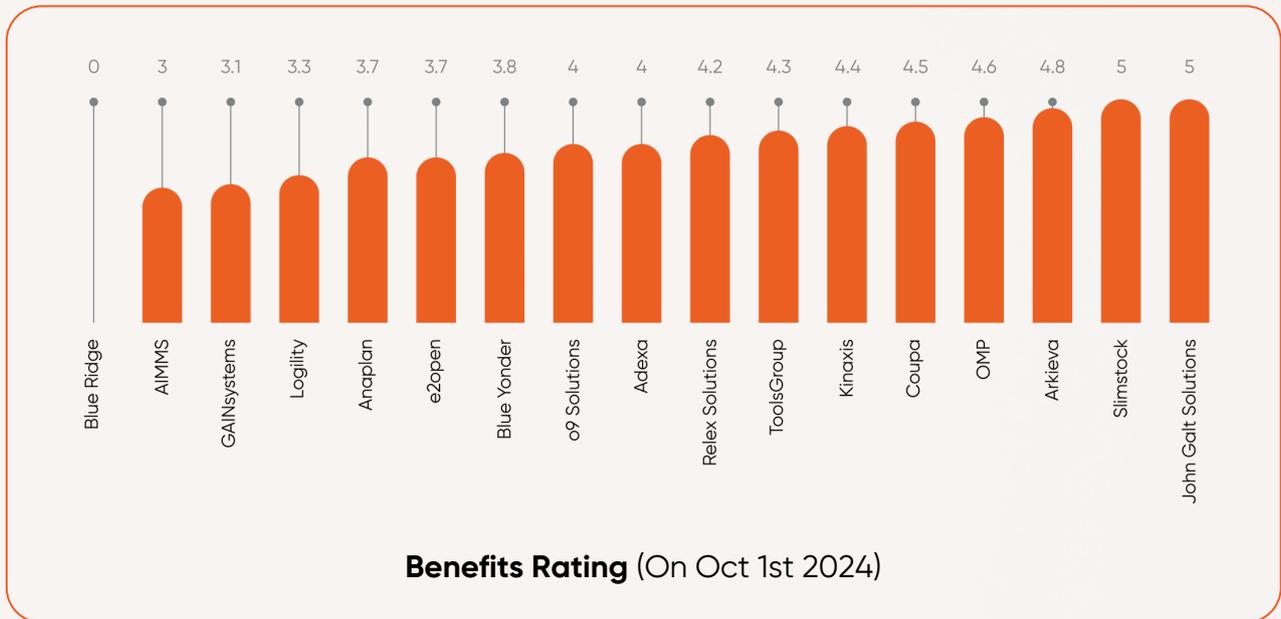
The difficulty level of interviews differs among the companies. It can impact both the quality of new hires and their talent acquisition efforts. Logility's challenging rating of 3.5 serves as a strong mechanism for screening out underqualified applicants, thereby enhancing the quality of hires. In contrast, OMP, Blue Ridge, and AIMMS strike a balance by evaluating skills comprehensively while making the process approachable.



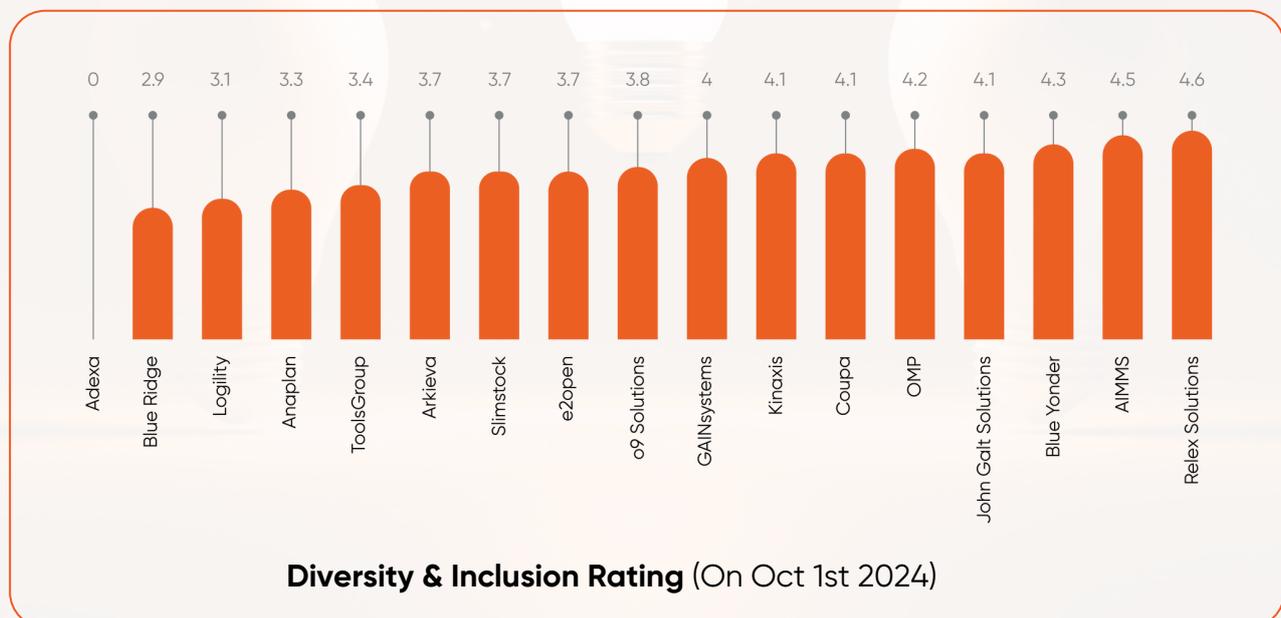
**Interview Difficulty Rating** (On Oct 1st 2024)

Slimstock, John Galt Solutions, and Blue Ridge are providing highly attractive benefit packages, which can significantly help in attracting new talent and retaining existing employees. In comparison to previous years, the benefits rating data has remained consistent, with GAINSystems, Logility, and Anaplan continuing to fall behind their competitors.



High diversity and inclusion ratings improve a company's reputation, making it more appealing to potential hires and assisting in the retention of current employees by promoting a supportive culture. In contrast, lower ratings can impede hiring efforts and increase turnover, as both prospective and current employees may look for more inclusive environments. The high ratings for AIMMS (4.5) and Blue Yonder (4.3) indicate robust diversity and inclusion initiatives, likely making these companies attractive to a wider talent pool..

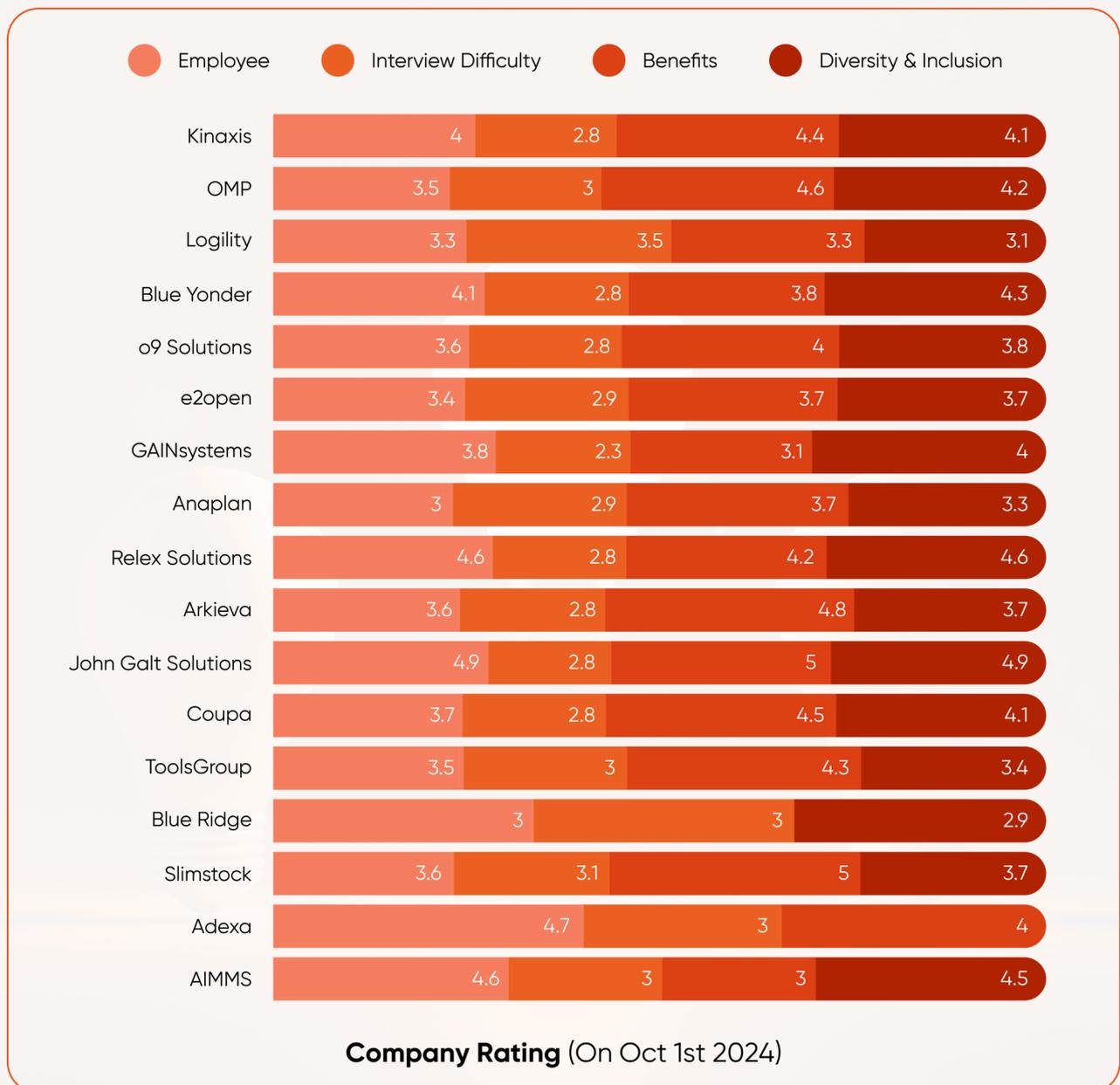


## Consolidated Company Ratings

The employee ratings for these companies reveal a range of strengths and areas for improvement across different metrics. Companies like AIMMS and Relex Solutions stand out with high ratings in employee satisfaction, benefits, and diversity and inclusion, indicating that they provide well-rounded and appealing work environments.

On the other hand, Logility is known for a more challenging interview process, which may limit its ability to attract talent. It also scores lower in diversity and inclusion, highlighting potential areas for enhancement.
